



Home Brew Contest

Entry Guidelines & Rules:

Registration packets must include the following:

1. Completed Registration Form
2. 24 oz of the brew bottles or growler
3. \$10 Entry Fee. \$5 Additional Entries
3. Each Applicant gets \$10. off tickets to Valley Brew Fest.
4. Applicants can submit up to 3 different brews. Each brew requires a separate registration.

Awards:

Entries will be divided into 4 categories: **IPAs, Ambers, Stouts/Porters and Other(all other brews)**. Competition officials reserve the right to combine categories based on number of entries.

A winner from each category will be determined and win an award in that category. All four categories winners will be judged against each other for Best Brew. Winner overall takes home the Golden Growler, gets to brew their beer at Pitch Fork Brewery in Hudson, WI with the master brewer and put their beer on tap.

Winners will be announced at the Valley Brew Fest on Saturday, August 18th, 2018 @ 6 PM.

1. Every member entering must be at least 21 years of age. Judges and Professional Brewers are permitted to be entrants as long as the entry was not brewed on commercial equipment
2. Every entry must be submitted with a bottle identification label attached to each bottle with a rubber band. The entry form must list the following information for entries in the categories specified: Name of Beer and name of person entering beer.
3. A panel of at least two judges will judge each entry according to the category in which it was entered. No judge will be assigned to a category for which they are entrants. All contestants will receive the score sheets with judges' comments for their entries.
4. All entries become the property of the Valley Brew Fest and will not be returned. Bottle and growlers will be available for pick up day of event. Any questions or disputes will be settled by the competition organizers, and all decisions are final.
